



CALIFORNIA PRIVACY POLICY

As a California resident, you have additional rights over the personal information that we collect about you that is not already protected by existing federal privacy laws. This California Privacy Policy describes the personal information that Benjamin F. Edwards & Co. (BFE) and Benjamin F. Edwards Wealth Management, LLC (EWM) (collectively, “we,” “us” and “our”) collect about you, the rights you have with respect to that information, and how you can exercise those rights. This information supplements the information contained in our Privacy Notice.

Information we have collected about you in the last 12 months.

Depending on your relationship with us and your activities with us, we collect personal information about you. In some instances, we need to share certain personal information with others to carry out our business purposes. Sensitive Personal Information

We do not use or disclose sensitive personal information for purposes other than permitted by law.

Your rights.

- You have the right to know the categories and/or specific pieces of your personal information that we have collected, used, and disclosed in the preceding 12 months, the categories of sources from which we have collected personal information, the business or commercial purpose(s) for which we have collected, sold, or shared your personal information, and the categories of third parties to whom we have disclosed your personal information.
- You have the right to delete personal information that we collect from you (under certain circumstances).
- You have the right to correct inaccurate information that we maintain about you.
- You have the right to opt out of the sale of sharing of your personal information.
- You have the right to not to be denied goods or services or charged different prices just because you have exercised your privacy rights.

How to submit a request to know, delete, or correct personal information.

To submit a request to know, delete, or correct your personal information, you may call us (toll-free) at (855) 382-1600 or e-mail us at privacy@benjaminfedwards.com. Please do not send us your account number via e-mail.

We will aim to respond to your request within 45 days. If we require more time to respond (up to a total of 90 days), we will inform you of the reason and extension period in writing. If we deny your request, we will explain the reason(s) for our denial.

We will verify your identity. If you submit a request to know, delete, or correct your personal information, we will verify your identity. We will match pieces of personal information provided by you with personal information maintained by us that we have determined are reliable. We may also require that you submit a signed declaration under penalty of perjury stating that you are the individual whose personal information is the subject of the request.

In some instances there is no reasonable method by which we can verify your identity. This is

the case, for example, when you visit our website. In that circumstance, we collect your Internet Protocol address and information about your activity on our website, but we do not associate this information with any named actual person or account.

You may designate an authorized agent to submit a request on your behalf. You have the right to authorize an agent to submit a request to know, delete, or correct personal information on your behalf. To have an authorized agent submit a request on your behalf, call us at (855) 382-1600 (toll-free) or e-mail us at privacy@benjamineedwards.com and tell us that you would like to authorize an agent to submit a request to know, delete, or correct on your behalf.

You will need to provide us with written permission authorizing the agent to submit a request to know, delete, or correct on your behalf. We will still verify your identity and will verify that you have given your authority to the agent.
